


IKHAYA LABANTU CARE HOME

Very soon a soup kitchen was added, which evolved into a homeless shelter which continued to operate until Ikhaya Labantu Care Home in its current form was established about 10 years ago. A 37-year story of resilience and grace, hardship and triumph, despair and hope. The story continues today as both Ikhaya Labantu Care Home and Eyabantu Creche continue to care for the very young and the old and frail, on the shared premises in Johnson Ngwevela Street, Langa.
